2. Wax sealed quotations should be submitted through registered / speed post / courier only. Tenders submitted by hand shall not be accepted.

The documentary evidence of the equipment conformity to the bidding documents may be in the form of literature and shall furnish a detailed description of the equipment; current prices of all spare parts, special tools etc. ; a clause-by-clause commentary on the specifications ; warranty; after sale services etc.
4. The Technology of the equipment should be current and shall continue to be operational for sufficient period to be mentioned in this offer. During this period, supplier shall give firm guarantee to supply spares on continuing basis.
5. The date of opening of tenders shall be communicated separately.
6. Rates inclusive of all taxes (where applicable) should be quoted F.O.R Bhaderwah Campus, Bhaderwah.
7. The rates quoted will be valid till the supply is made in full.
8. The items must be quoted in strict accordance to the specifications mentioned against each item.
9. The items have to be supplied in standard packing.
10. Supply shall have to be made within 15 days from the date of issue of supply order.
